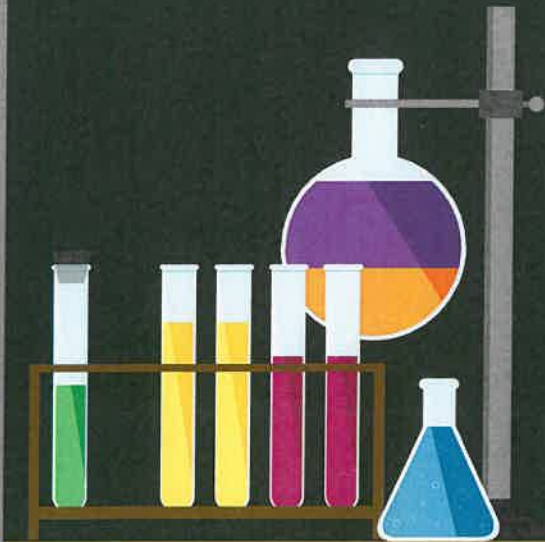


CHEMISTRY KILLS

Cigarettes today contain more than
**7,000 CHEMICALS
AND COMPOUNDS**
with hundreds that are toxic and about
70 proven to cause cancer.



599 ADDITIVES

are on the composite list of what may be added to cigarettes that the tobacco companies released to the government in 1994. This list includes all ingredients that are used; although, it does not state which companies they are used by or which brands they are used in.



CARBON MONOXIDE

is a toxic gas, which can cause death, found in tobacco smoke.

HYDRAZINE

is found in rocket fuel. It's also found in cigarettes.



RADIOACTIVE POLONIUM-210

is found in cigarette smoke. Polonium-210 contributes to cancer.



HYDROGEN CYANIDE

exposure causes cardiovascular and respiratory illness. There's hydrogen cyanide in rat poison. There's also hydrogen cyanide in tobacco smoke.



FORMALDEHYDE

is found in embalming fluid that's used to preserve the dead. Formaldehyde is also found in cigarette smoke.



ACETONE

removes nail polish. It is also found in cigarette smoke.

TOLUENE

is found in gasoline. It's also found in cigarette smoke.
