COVID-19 EXPECTATIONS WHILE ON CAMPUS

Public health officials are recommending actions to reduce exposure to COVID-19. These actions can help slow the spread and reduce the impact of disease.

- **Social distancing 6 feet apart** always, inside or outside FCTC campus.
- U Wear a **mask when you cannot social distance; always** have a mask with you.
- Hand sanitizing and washing hands frequently with soap and water and use hand sanitizer.
 Wash hands when returning to campus during learning lab time.
- Quarantine if you had close contact with a person with COVID-19, stay home until 14 days after your last exposure, check your temperature twice a day, monitor symptoms and stay away from high risk people. If symptoms develop, call Joanna Nelson, Dept. of Health, (904) 209-3250, listen to the menu and choose option #3 (if lines are busy leave name, reason for call and call back number). Students email/call their instructor. Teachers and staff email/call their supervisor.
- Isolate yourself if you have been diagnosed with COVID-19, waiting on test results or have cough, fever, shortness of breath or other COVID-19 symptoms. Stay home and contact Joanna Nelson, Dept. of Health, (904) 209-3250, listen to the menu and choose option #3 (if all lines are busy leave name, reason for call and call back number). If you live with others, stay in a specific "sick room" or area and away from other people including pets. Use a separate bathroom, if available. Students email/call their instructor. Teachers and staff email/call their supervisor. 7/1/2020
