

# How to Pay for College

Money for college is more available than you may think. Use this guide to start your search for funding that will help ensure your success at *FCTC.* 



## **SCHOLARSHIPS**

Scholarships are gifts of money that don't need to be repaid. Thousands of scholarships are offered by schools, employers, individuals, private companies, nonprofits, communities, religious groups, professional associations and social organizations. You may be awarded a scholarship for being a good student or a great basketball player, because your parent works for a particular company or for many other reasons.



# **FEDERAL STUDENT AID**

Scholarships, grants and loans are available through the federal government. All students are eligible to submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). There are no fees to apply; however, you will need to provide personal information.



## GRANTS

Like scholarships, grants are free gifts of money that do not need to be repaid. Start with the resources listed on this page to identify grants sources for which you may qualify.

Once you have completed the FAFSA, you should pursue and submit as many scholarship and grant applications as you can. But before you apply for any assistance, learn how to spot potential fraud and scams. Protect your identity and remember that most scholarships and grants do not charge a fee for application, so be selective. Do not submit any financial aid applications without thoroughly checking out its legitimacy.

Start your research early, meet your deadlines, and you will be on your way to scholarship success!
