- 1. Reside in one of our region's 6 counties: Baker, Clay, Duval, Nassau, Putnam or St. Johns;
- 2. Be a U.S. citizen, or have legal alien status;
- 3. Be at least 18 years old;
- 4. If you are unemployed, been laid off of from your last employment, eligible for unemployment compensation, or if your company closed permanently; or
- 5. Are employed, but earning less than \$30.00 per hour.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

- Entering the Core program, you must have a 2.75 GPA or higher.
- You can not have any defaulted student loans.
- If you are male born after 1963, you must be registered for the selective service.
- You may be required to complete aptitude/interest assessments.

If you are interested in participating, contact via email one of our Workforce Service Representatives listed closest to your home address. In the email, make sure to include your name, program of study, current GPA and term attending. If you do qualify for a scholarship, Career-Source Northeast Florida may be able to pay for tuition, fees and books. Costs such as uniforms, licensing and exams may also be covered.
