

OPEN DOOR GRANT



The Open Door Grant Program 2023-2024 is a Financial Aid Program offered by First Coast Technical College and funded by the Florida Department of Education. The program is designed to incentivize current and future workers to enroll in career and technical education programs that lead to a credential, certificate or degree.

The Grant covers 100% of tuition and fees associated with the eligible programs not otherwise covered by Federal Grants, State Grant or other Third-Party payments.

Grant Funds are limited and not all students will be awarded funds.

Funds are subject to availability and will be awarded once the application is approved and all other aid is applied. Refer to application for more details.

Applications should be submitted in-person to the Financial Aid Office in Building A on our Main Campus.



Criteria

Students enrolled in an eligible Career Technical Education program and meet Florida Residency for Tuition Purposes may qualify.

New Students

Once you receive an acceptance/ready to register letter from our Admissions Office, submit the Open Door application in person to the Financial Aid Office in Building A on our Main Campus to determine eligibility.

Funds are subject to availability and priority is given to currently enrolled students. Students who are considered non-Florida residents for tuition purposes do not qualify even if receiving a fee exemption for out-of-state tuition fees. Open Door Grant funds are applied after federal and state aid, or third-party payments, to cover a maximum award equal to the amount needed to cover 100% of tuition and fees for the term. First Coast Technical College is required to reduce or cancel the grant award if the student later becomes eligible for other financial assistance during the 2023-24 school year. Awarded funds only apply to the program for which the application is submitted.
